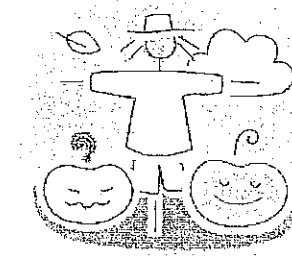
Attention
