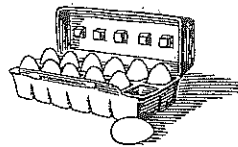

## Friday's muffin morning

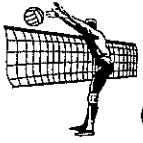
8<sup>th</sup> grade fundraiser big muffins for \$2

## Cross Country News

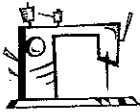
Great job runners. Hailey O had a goal of making top 10 and she came in 7<sup>th</sup>, Brady O & Justine T also placed.

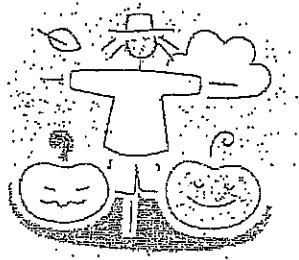
