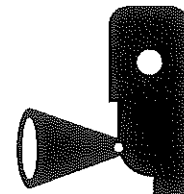

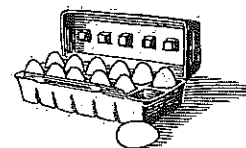

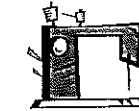
### Dismissal

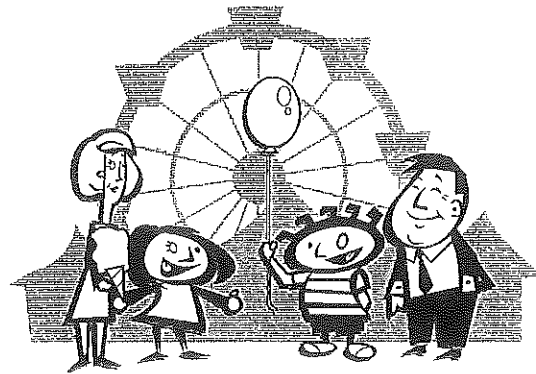
